
The subject work Notice Inviting Tender as referred above is published on Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) & Institute website (i.e., www.iith.ac.in). Due to recent modifications in Performance Guarantee clause vide no. DG/Manual-2024/20 dated: 27.02.2026 issued by the authority of Director General, CPWD, the Performance Guarantee clauses have been modified in respect of General Conditions of Contract (GCC) Clause - 1 & Tender Schedule - E as below:
